Woodshire's First Earth Day Event - A Great Success!

Nearly 75 neighbors turned out for our very first Woodshire Earth Day celebration on Saturday April 22, 2023.

Trees for Houston donated 96 different varieties of trees to Woodshire Civic Club (WCC) including Pecans, Pines and 3 types of Oaks. Our Civic Club President, Christian Gubitza along with Troy Troxell, Jon Le Grand and Eric Pieters picked up all the trees from the distribution center along with 100 bags of mulch and unloaded them at the event site to track and distribute to neighbors. Some neighbors planted their own trees, and WCC's hardest-working member, Troy Troxell not only donated the mulch but planted at least 45 trees for neighbors along with several for our esplanades!

Civic Club members Jon, Franny and Astrid Le Grand manned a Rain Barrel display which showcased the optimum set-up and offered deeply discounted Rain Barrel sale prices from the City of Houston. Mary Shapiro donated at least 900 free plants, and hundreds of seed packets. Children created crafts & artsy rocks and other items to take home. Jonna Hitchcock DJ'd and signed up new members to the Civic Club. We had a Vegan Bakery vendor selling cookies & cheesecakes. Bendi Saindon kept us all hydrated with her refreshing lemonade stand. We'd like to thank everyone who participated, volunteered and donated supplies.

TWO MAJOR SECURITY UPDATES

➤➤➤ OUR NEWLY CERTIFIED CITIZENS ON PATROL VOLUNTEER PROGRAM IS LIVE!

The Citizens have been recently certified by Houston Police Department (HPD) to actively patrol their neighborhoods to watch for and report suspicious and/or criminal activity. These members are additional “eyes and ears” for our HPD.

Volunteers choose the days and times they wish to patrol, and they adhere to no fixed schedule. Our Citizens on Patrol volunteer program is not affiliated with the Civic Club but will have some of our members as volunteers.

➤➤➤ BETTER CAMERA SYSTEM COMING SOON! DONATE TO THE SECURITY FUND!

Currently we have 2 medium-resolution camera systems (Latma entrance and 4115 Leeshire).

We have started a campaign soon for a more advanced security camera and monitoring service for the Leeshire entrance which can capture license plates and provide better video and storage capabilities. We need to raise ~\$2500. The goal is to:

- Assist police to identify suspicious vehicles when crimes have occurred
- Discourage criminals from targeting our neighborhood

We coordinate with the city to enforce deed restrictions and get action on needed repairs and maintenance.
