

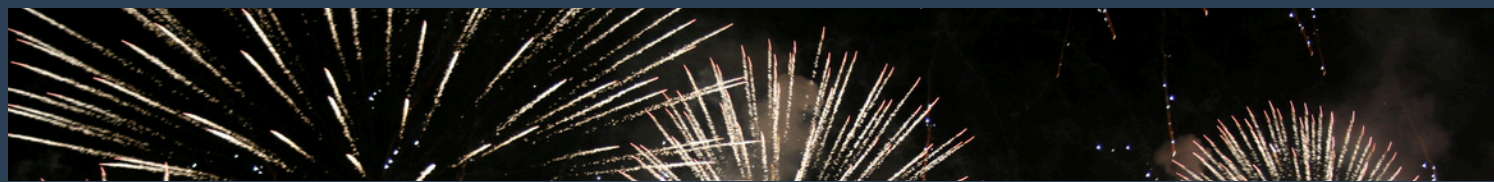

Dear Woodshire Neighbors,

As the new year begins, it brings an opportunity to strengthen and invest in the community we all share. To help set Woodshire up for a successful year, we're asking homeowners to submit their 2026 civic club dues by March 31, 2026.

Receiving dues early in the year allows us to plan responsibly, schedule projects with confidence, and maintain the services that help make Woodshire a safe, welcoming, and well-maintained neighborhood for residents and property owners alike.

Last year, participation was lower than we hoped, with just 59.6% of homeowners contributing. While everyone enjoys the benefits of civic club efforts, those services are only possible when the community comes together to support them. Increased participation in 2026 will make a meaningful difference.

We're proud to say that annual dues remain \$200, the same amount they've been for nearly 10 years. This rate is still well below what many nearby neighborhoods pay for similar services. For those who are able and wish to further support Woodshire, Gold Memberships (\$300) and Platinum Memberships (\$500) are available.

Woodshire's strength has always come from its people. With your support, we can continue building a neighborhood that looks out for one another and remains a great place to live.
